## **COVID-19 Immunity Bill Update**

The Bill is currently in Missouri's House Special Committe on Litigation Reform. Movement on the COVID-19 Immunity Bill is expected this summer.

This Bill RAISES the standards by which a Plaintiff must prove misconduct that caused an injury. It protects companies from responsibility when they improperly expose people to COVID-19. It would also tie injuries NOT really related to COVID-19 under this liability shield due to its poor and broad wording.
